Kore Power Selects Yates to Design-Build Lithium Battery Facility

KORE Power, Inc. announced today that its KOREPlex facility in Buckeye, Arizona, will be built by nationally recognized advanced manufacturing design-build company, Yates Construction. "Our groundbreaking facility needed a partner with extensive experience in delivering advanced manufacturing facilities that offer the technological and sustainability targets that the KOREPlex will achieve," said Lindsay Gorrill, KORE Power CEO. Some of the advanced manufacturing attributes of the KOREPlex will include fully automated cell assembly

The facility will be fully climate-controlled and will include a solar-ready covered employee parking lot. The KOREPlex will produce nearly 60 million battery cells annually to support a reliable and independent U.S. supply chain for lithium-ion battery cells, which are critical to the future of electric vehicles, power grids, and more. The facility will have the capacity to produce enough power for 3.2 million homes each year. KORE plans to start construction of the facility by the end of the year with the goal of beginning production in mid-2023.
